



REQUIREMENTS FOR BECOMING A PLAY OF LIFE PRACTITIONER

1. Completion of the six-day Play of Life Coaching Accreditation Course
2. 50 Hours of logged practise with friends and family
3. 12 hours of Peer Supervision accumulated by practising with virtual case studies in front of other Play of Life Students and filing your Peer-evaluation sheets with your log record. This can also be partly accumulated by attending the Professional Supervision days offered throughout the year with Carlos.
4. 12 Hours of Professional Supervision done one on one with Carlos @ \$150/hour or accumulated by participating in the group Professional Supervision days (\$20-25/hour)*.
* During the Professional Supervision Days (5 hours), the following applies:
 - Full-day attendance= 5 hours credit towards *Peer* Supervision requirements.
 - Full-day attendance= 2 hours towards *Professional* Supervision requirements.
 - 1 hour playing a "client" = .5 hour towards Professional Supervision requirements.
 - 1 hour playing "the coach" in front of the Supervisor= 1 hour towards Professional Supervision requirements.
5. Formal Approval of Dr Carlos A. Raimundo after which a certificate will be issued and your name will be registered as a Practitioner on the website.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- To maintain accreditation, at least 2 Master Training days on specialized topics must be attended per year @ \$150/day.**
- Practitioners must have their own Professional Indemnity and Public Liability Insurance in place.**
- People who have met the above requirements will be accredited to use the Play of Life techniques for coaching purposes on the condition they will not train others or replicate the materials provided to them for training purposes.**



REQUIREMENTS FOR BECOMING A PLAY OF LIFE TRAINER OF MODULES I & II

1. You must be an accredited Play of Life Practitioner.
2. A formal application stating your experience as a presenter, teacher, trainer.
3. References supporting your effectiveness as a trainer.
4. Repeat attendance of Modules I & II @\$150 per day. Should you feel you need to attend all or part of Modules I & II a third time, there will be no charge but attendance is subject to availability of space in any course.
4. You must organise a group of at least 8 colleagues, family or friends with whom to practice teaching Modules I and II. This can be done with other Practitioners wherein separate sections of the modules are taught by each person. A Play of Life Supervisor must be present to evaluate the effectiveness of implementation.
5. Formal Approval of Dr Carlos A. Raimundo after which a certificate will be issued and your name will be registered as a Licensed Trainer of Modules I & II on the website.

1. You must be an accredited Play of Life Trainer for Modules I & II
2. Provide evaluation sheets from students of Modules I & II supporting your effectiveness as a trainer.
3. Repeat attendance of Modules III & IV @\$150 per day. Should you feel you need to attend all or part of Modules III & IV a third time, there will be no charge but attendance is subject to availability of space in any course.
4. You must organise a group of at least 8 family or friends with whom to practice teaching Modules III and IV .This can be done with other Practitioners wherein separate sections of the modules are taught by each person. A Play of Life Supervisor must be present to evaluate the effectiveness of implementation.
5. Formal Approval of Dr Carlos A. Raimundo after which a certificate will be issued and your name will be registered as a Licensed Trainer of Modules III & IV on the website.
